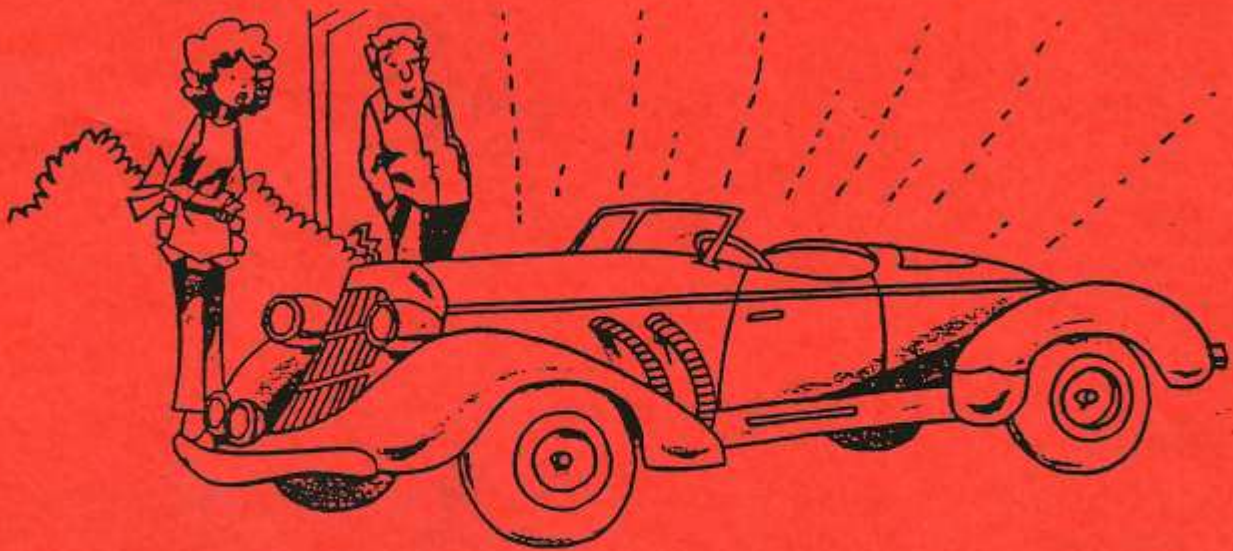
Also worth mentioning are other parades, Old Geezer breakfasts every week, circle tour, Great American Race, our annual fund raiser the Swap Meet, and more.
